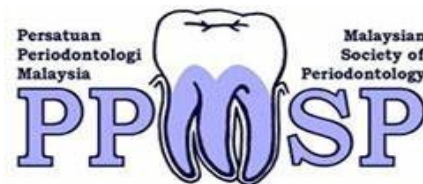

### What is New in the Classification of Periodontal & Implant Disease?

The recent announcement on the new classification of periodontal and implant disease by the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP) has created some concerns among dental practitioners about its definition and usage in general practice. With high prevalence of periodontal disease and needs for treatment among our Malaysian population, early detection and timely intervention is crucial to ensure that all individuals and groups at risk are being identified, diagnosed and treated effectively. Hence, this session will share the updates on the 2017 Classification of Periodontal & Implant diseases and highlight the impact as well as benefits of identifying patients at risk.

### Non-Surgical Periodontics Hands-on: Are You Using Your Scalers Optimally?

This hands-on session will provide updates on use of ultrasonic scalers for dental prophylaxis and share tips on how to optimise their use in general dental practice. The participants will also be introduced to the air polishing technique as a new approach of Guided Biofilm Therapy (GBT) to enhance better outcomes of therapy for patients with periodontal disease and implant supportive care.

An adequate understanding of the relationship between periodontal tissues and restorative dentistry is crucial. A healthy periodontal tissues provides a good foundation for an aesthetic and functional restoration/prostheses. Therefore, it is important to identify the elements in restorative treatment that can be contributed to achieve and maintain the health of periodontal tissues. ### Periodontal Screening - Early Management And Referral.

Periodontal disease, is a silent but most common oral condition. The simplest and most convenient way to detect it is by periodontal screening using the Basic Periodontal Examination (BPE) procedure. This should be performed for all new patients, and also on a regular basis. This lecture will enlighten the BPE protocols /benefit, and the disease complexity level to decide whether the patient can be managed at the general practice only or needed to be referred to a periodontist.
